

LYNSAY: WHAT'S UP, DMV! I'M LYNSAY, YOUR HOST, AND WELCOME TO BILLIARDS MUSIC MAGAZINE. WE'RE HERE AT FORD'S THEATRE FOR THIS SPECIAL DMV EDITION, AND YOU KNOW WE HAD TO KICK THINGS OFF WITH SOMEONE AMAZING. TODAY, WE'RE SHINING THE SPOTLIGHT ON THE ONE AND ONLY GËTTE (AKA KAIYLA B. GROSS). GËTTE, THANK YOU SO MUCH FOR BEING HERE.

LYNSAY: YOU'RE BACK AT FORD'S THEATRE FOR A CHRISTMAS CAROL. HOW DOES IT FEEL TO RETURN?

GËTTE: IT FEELS AMAZING. THIS IS MY SECOND YEAR DOING A CHRISTMAS CAROL, AND I ALSO DID LITTLE SHOP OF HORRORS HERE LAST SPRING. I LOVE THIS THEATER SO MUCH—IT'S GOT A RICH HISTORY, AND IT'S SUCH A RESPECTED SPACE.

LYNSAY: FORD'S THEATRE REALLY IS ICONIC, AND IT FEELS LIKE A FULL-CIRCLE MOMENT SEEING YOU HERE. LET'S REWIND A BIT, THOUGH—WHAT FIRST SPARKED YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH MUSIC? WHEN DID YOU KNOW YOU HAD A GIFT?

GËTTE: HONESTLY? MAYBE
ABOUT A YEAR AGO. LIKE,
I'VE BEEN SINGING ALL MY
LIFE, TECHNICALLY, BUT I
DIDN'T REALLY START
BELIEVING IN MY VOICE
UNTIL JUNIOR YEAR OF
COLLEGE. AND EVEN THEN,
IT WASN'T UNTIL I STARTED
GIGGING LAST YEAR THAT
I FULLY EMBRACED IT.

LYNSAY: THAT'S SO REAL.

SOCIAL MEDIA AND ALL THE
OUTSIDE NOISE CAN MAKE US
QUESTION OURSELVES, BUT
WHEN YOU KNOW, YOU KNOW. I
LOVE HOW HONEST YOU ARE
ABOUT THE PROCESS—IT
SHOWS HOW MUCH YOU CARE
ABOUT PLANTING THOSE SEEDS
AND GROWING.



GËTTE: THANK YOU! YEAH,
IT'S BEEN A PROCESS, FOR
SURE. I NEVER WANT TO
STOP LEARNING OR
GROWING.

LYNSAY: I WANT TO TALK ABOUT YOUR NAME CHANGE—FROM KAIYLA TO GËTTE. WHAT INSPIRED THAT?

GËTTE: MY MOM PASSED
AWAY TWO YEARS AGO,
AND SHE NAMED ME
AFTER MY GODMOTHER,
WHO ALSO PASSED. MY
MIDDLE NAME IS
BRIGETTE, SO I CHOSE
"GËTTE" AS A WAY TO
HONOR BOTH OF THEM.

LYNSAY: THAT'S SO
BEAUTIFUL. DO THEY
INFLUENCE YOUR
MUSIC AND
PERFORMANCES?

GËTTE: DEFINITELY. I FEEL LIKE IF I BELIEVE WHAT I'M SINGING, OTHER PEOPLE WILL FEEL IT TOO, I DON'T SING SONGS I DON'T CONNECT WITH EMOTIONALLY OR THAT I CAN'T **TELL A STORY** THROUGH.



HONORING HER ROOTS

LYNSAY: AS BOTH A SINGER AND ACTRESS, DO YOU FEEL LIKE THOSE TWO PARTS OF YOU INFLUENCE EACH OTHER?

TAUGHT ME SO MUCH ABOUT MY
VOICE—RANGE, PLACEMENTS,
EVEN FINDING WHISTLE NOTES I
DIDN'T KNOW I HAD! IT'S ALSO
HELPED WITH STAGE PRESENCE,
WHICH CARRIES OVER WHEN I'M
GIGGING.

LYNSAY: THAT'S SO CLEAR IN YOUR PERFORMANCES. SPEAKING OF THEATER, LET'S TALK ABOUT THE COLOR PURPLE. YOUR PORTRAYAL OF CELIE WAS UNFORGETTABLE. DID THAT ROLE BOOST YOUR CONFIDENCE?

GËTTE: HONESTLY, I DON'T THINK
CELIE WAS THE MOMENT FOR ME. I
WAS SO YOUNG, AND I DON'T
THINK I FULLY UNDERSTOOD
EVERYTHING THE ROLE ENTAILED.
IT WASN'T UNTIL I DID RENT AT
SIGNATURE THEATRE THAT I FELT
LIKE, "OKAY, I CAN REALLY DO
THIS." THAT'S WHEN I QUIT MY
9-TO-5 AND COMMITTED TO
THEATER FULL-TIME.

OF FAITH, AND IT'S CLEAR IT
PAID OFF. HAVING PEOPLE
WHO BELIEVE IN YOU MUST
HAVE MADE A DIFFERENCE.

GËTTE: DEFINITELY. MY

PUSHED ME TO QUIT MY JOB
AND GO FOR IT. I'M SO
GRATEFUL FOR PEOPLE LIKE
HER WHO SEE THE
POTENTIAL IN ME, EVEN
WHEN I DON'T SEE IT
MYSELF..



LYNSAY:
YOUR SINGLE
YOUR REALLY
HITS DEEP.
CAN YOU
SHARE WHAT
INSPIRED IT?

GETTE: I RECORDED VOID ALMOST TWO YEARS AGO AS A REFERENCE TRACK. A FRIEND OF MINE, WROTE IT KNOWING WHAT I WAS GOING THROUGH WITH MY MOM. AT FIRST, IT WAS JUST SUPPOSED TO BE A REFERENCE, BUT HE ENCOURAGED ME TO RELEASE IT. WE EVEN PERFORMED IT LIVE DURING ONE OF **OUR "CUTS AND CONCERTS"** SESSIONS, AND IT DID SO WELL THAT WE DECIDED TO RECORD AND RELEASE IT. I DROPPED IT ON MY MOM'S BIRTHDAY THIS YEAR, WHICH MADE IT EVEN MORE SPECIAL.



LYNSAY: THAT'S SO
POWERFUL. I CAN
HEAR THE
EMOTION IN YOUR
YOICE WHEN YOU
PERFORM. IT'S
YULNERABLE, BUT
THAT'S WHAT
MAKES IT HIT SO
HARD.

GËTTE: THANK YOU. I
JUST WANT PEOPLE
TO FEEL SOMETHING
WHEN THEY HEAR IT
—NOT JUST THINK,
"OH, SHE CAN SING,"
BUT REALLY FEEL IT.



LYNSAY: YOU'RE CONSTANTLY EVOLVING, AND WE'RE ALL EXCITED TO SEE WHAT'S NEXT. CAN YOU TELL US ABOUT YOUR UPCOMING EP?

GËTTE: YES! I'M WORKING ON A FOUR-SONG
EP CALLED FOR YOU. I'M HOPING TO
RELEASE IT IN FEBRUARY. IT'S PERSONAL—
SONGS ABOUT LOVE, LOSS, AND THE
PEOPLE WHO'VE SHAPED MY JOURNEY.

LYNSAY: GËTTE, THANK YOU SO MUCH FOR JOINING US AND SHARING YOUR JOURNEY. ANY FINAL WORDS FOR THE BILLIARDS FAMILY?


GËTTE: STAY TRUE TO YOURSELF.
